Week # 3 September 20th – 24th

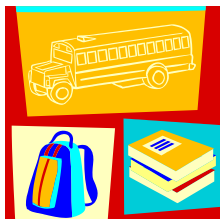
Theme: Measure Up

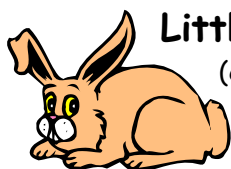
